Main Purpose

To ensure the designated areas of the school are cleaned to appropriate specifications in accordance with Health and Safety requirements, to ensure a clean, hygienic and safe environment for teaching and other school activities to take place.

Main Responsibilities and Duties

- Working with some supervision to an established work pattern
- Empty waste bins and dispose of collection bag contents safely
- Wash, clean and polish floors using appropriate machinery and cleaning agents
- Wipe down, dust and polish furniture in a careful and thorough manner, checking tables, chairs and fixtures for any damage likely to cause injury
- Undertake deep-cleaning during some holiday periods, including washing walls, furniture and fixtures where required
- Operate a safe working environment within the buildings by displaying appropriate Health & Safety signs etc.
- Maintain the cleaning storage area in a clean, tidy and safe condition
- Refer any issues, breakages or difficulties to the Cleaning Supervisor in a timely manner to ensure that health and safety requirements are maintained at all times
- The post-holder may from time to time be required to carry out other cleaning duties commensurate with the role

Physical Working Conditions

- This is a physical role and candidates should expect to be standing, walking and working throughout.
- Physical work, cleaning using potentially hazardous cleaning agents (COSHH Training is required and can be offered for suitable candidates)
- Cleaning equipment/machinery is in various sizes and weights (e.g. polishers, scrubbing machines, wet vacs) and should be handled in an appropriate manner in accordance with instructions and specifications provided
- Working conditions can require being adaptable to different work areas, including bending, kneeling and stretching as well as working in confined areas
- The role typically involves the cleaning of toilets, classrooms, corridors, kitchens, foyers, laboratories and office areas

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Education and Qualifications

- Previous experience of cleaning in a school/industrial environment (desirable)
- COSHH Training (desirable)
- Health and Safety experience/understanding in a similar or role (desirable)

Skills, Knowledge and Abilities

- Highly motivated, enthusiastic and able to work as part of a team
- Self-motivated and able to use own initiative
- Adaptable and able show flexibility to situations as they change
- Be willing to undertake Safeguarding Training and other online courses

Relationships

- Reports to the Cleaning Supervisor
- Has no direct supervision of other staff
- Has some contact with staff, students, parents and members of the public
- Able to work effectively within a team
