## RE: Yeovil College Experience Day – Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2025

I am writing with advanced notice of a Year 10 trip for all students on Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2025 to Yeovil College.

The Yeovil College Experience Day is an opportunity for students to attend the College and experience some of the subjects that the college has to offer young people as they move on from compulsory schooling to their future in education and training post-16.

Wadham students will also get the experience of Yeovil College as a campus and see how students move around throughout their day and use the facilities related to their course and non-contact time.
